



From the A30 roundabout follow signs for St Ives.

Continue on the A3074 through Lelant and Carbis Bay for approximately 3 miles. When you reach the St Ives Harbour Hotel turn right at the junction and follow the road down the hill with the sea to your right.

Once in the town centre continue down Tregenna Hill onto Tregenna Place and follow the road around to the right at Barclays Bank onto High Street.

Follow the one-way system around Market Place to the harbour front and follow the sea-front along the harbour on Wharf Road. When you reach the Sloop Inn turn left up Fish Street.

\*Slow down and pull in on the left\* - if you continue too far you will have to follow the one-way system all the way around town.

Your parking space is in a shared garage on the left just after the Sloop car park - you will first need to park your car in the garage and offload from there.

Pilchard Cottage is a further 30 metres up Fish Street on the left, the front door key and garage key will be in the key-safe (code as emailed).

## Parking information

After following Wharf Road along the harbour-front turn left just after the Sloop Inn up Fish Street.

Pull in to the left.



Pilchard Cottage is 30 metres further up Fish Street on the left. The house key and garage key will be in the key-safe next to the front door - you will have been emailed the door code.



The garage door is operated by inserting the key and turning a quarter to the right and releasing. Please note that you will have to pull the key out slightly in order to turn.

Please be aware that the garage entrance is restricted to vehicles of 6'3" / 1.9m, so not suitable for larger SUV's or vehicles with a roof box.



Once open there is a pull cord for the light just inside on the right.

Your space is diagonally to the right, next to the boat.

Please be aware of areas of low ceiling when navigating your way through the garage.





The parking space is 6'3" / 1.9m wide, from the wall on the left to the middle of the white line on the right.

The boat in the next space has been in the garage for many years so is unlikely to move!



To exit the garage reverse back out in the same way that you entered, taking care as you exit onto Fish Street.

Please close the garage door after exiting by pressing the 'down' button just inside the door next to the light pull cord.
