


Directions to Sanderling Cottage



From the A30 roundabout follow signs for St Ives. Continue on the A3074 through Lelant and Carbis Bay for approximately 4 miles until you reach the St Ives Harbour Hotel.

Turn right at this junction and follow the road (The Terrace) down hill with the sea to your right.

Follow the road as it bends to the left after the train and bus stations, then again to the right as the road goes downhill onto Tregenna Hill and into the town centre.

Continue straight on until the road bends sharply to the right on to High Street.

At the bottom of High Street follow the one-way system to the left and then to the right around Market Place, then follow the road (Lifeboat Hill) down the hill to the harbour.

After turning sharply to the left follow Wharf Road along the harbour-front until you reach the Sloop Inn, then turn immediately to the left and continue to the top of Fish Street (ensuring that you don't follow St Peters Street around to the left or you will have to drive around the town again).

At the top of Fish Street turn right and Sanderling Cottage is on the left approx. 50 metres on.

Please note, you might prefer to offload to the rear of the cottage on the quieter St Eia Street, in which case turn left into Burrow Road and then immediately right on to St Eia Street. Sanderling is the sixth cottage on the right - look out for the white wall and grey gate that opens to rear courtyard.

There is a keysafe at both the front and rear of the cottage, both with the same key code.
